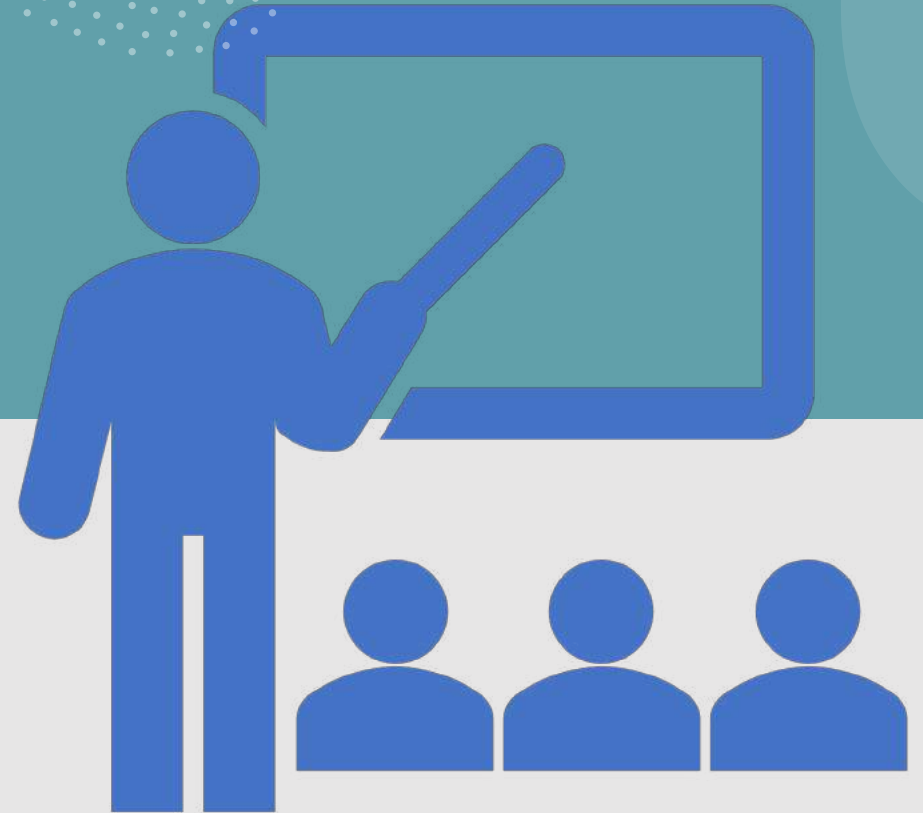


Brunel's commitment to ED&I

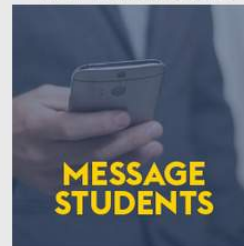
