ROLES AVAILABLE

PART TIME ROLE SUMMARY

Start date: 27th October 2025

Hours of work: 3+ hours commitment a week.

Contract: This is a voluntary position.

Benefits:

POSTGRADUATE OFFICER

Requirements:

- You must currently be enrolled at Brunel University.
- You must be studying for the academic year 25/26 (ideally for the whole year).
- You must be registered on either a postgraduate taught or postgraduate research course.
- You must be able to attend a remote campaign planning training session in November 2025.

Responsibilities:

- As the Postgraduate Officer, you will support postgraduate taught and postgraduate research students with their wellbeing and education.
- As the Postgraduate officer, you will chair the Student Union's Postgraduate Experience Group. The Postgraduate Experience Group consists of postgraduate taught and postgraduate research course reps.
- As the Postgraduate Officer You will contribute to the Student Union's Academic Support campaign, ensuring the campaign relates to the specific needs and struggles experienced by postgraduate students.

Mandatory Campaign:

As the Postgraduate Officer, you will be encouraged to create a campaign that raises awareness of the issues affecting postgraduate students.

Requirements:

- You must currently be enrolled at Brunel University and be an enrolled student for the majority of the 25/26 academic year.
- You must identify as a woman.
- You must be ordinarily resident in the UK without any immigration restriction are a British or Irish national who has lived in the UK, Republic of Ireland, the Isle of Man or the Channel Islands for three full years immediately before the first day of your course.
- You must be able to attend a campaign planning training session in November 2025.

Responsibilities:

- You will address issues affecting Home Students like transport and commuting, access to student funding, welfare support, inclusion, and cultural recognition.
- You will lead the Home Students' Network as well as oversee the development of an engaging, dynamic and rewarding community of home students.
- You will represent the needs and interests of home students within the Brunel Community. Working with the campaigns and student engagement co-ordinator, facilitate initiatives to support engagement across our diverse student communities.
- You will work with the other Home Students Officer to co-chair the Home Students Network.
- As Home Students Officer, you will create at least 1 innovative campaign that galvanize the Student Membership.

Mandatory Campaign:

As the Home Student Officer, you will create a campaign that specifically supports home students.

STUDENT ASSEMBLY ROLES

Student Assembly is a meeting of elected representatives to decide the policies and campaigns of the Union, making sure that it is working on the issues that matter to our members. They also hold the Student Officers to account, asking them questions about their decisions and making suggestions to them, to make sure that they are running the Union in the best way possible.

You must be able to attend the 5 scheduled meetings:

- Student Assembly Meeting 3 – Wednesday 28th January – 2pm-4pm
- Student Assembly Meeting 4 – Wednesday 22nd April – 2pm-4pm

15 x Student Assembly Community members

- You must currently be enrolled at Brunel University.
- You must be able to attend ALL Student Assembly meetings in 25/26.
- There are 15 community positions but target at least 5 of those to be Women (women candidates will be counted first when running results).

2 x Student Assembly Commuter Student members

- You must currently be enrolled at Brunel University.
- You must be able to attend all Student Assembly meetings in 25/26.
- 2 x roles available for Commuter students' positions, one of which will be targeted to be a Woman.
- A Commuter student will live more than a two-mile radius from the University and will be eligible to apply to park on site.

4 x Student Assembly Home Student Positions

- You must currently be enrolled at Brunel University.
- You must be able to attend all Student Assembly meetings in 25/26.
- 4 x roles available for home student representatives, with a target of at least 2 of them being women.
- A Home Student will be ordinarily resident in the UK without any immigration restriction are a British or Irish national who has lived in the UK, Republic of Ireland, the Isle of Man or the Channel Islands for three full years immediately before the first day of your course.
